Fellowship with Kansai Univ. Senior High School

We welcomed 26 students and 2 teachers from Kansai University Senior High School, which is also a Super Global High School designated by the Japanese Government. We held an exchange about what we have learned as project studies. In the former part of the program, we held a poster session.
