Read the article below and answer the following question.

Young Japanese feel short of self-confidence and are pessimistic about the future, according to a Cabinet Office survey.

The online survey, conducted from November to December 2013, covering people aged between 13 and 29 in Britain, France, Germany, Japan, South Korea, Sweden and the United States received responses from around 1,000 individuals in each country.

According to the survey, 86.0 percent of U.S. respondents said they were confident in themselves, ranking top among the seven countries. Japanese respondents ranked lowest at only 45.8 percent.

Japan also placed bottom for those responding that they possess positive characteristics. Asked if they see hope for the future and will be happy when they are 40 years old, the proportion of Japanese replying affirmatively was lowest for both questions.

A Cabinet Office official said, "It is necessary to enhance child-support programs and improve the quality of education of Japan in order to enable young people to boost their self-confidence."
