Read the passage below and answer the following question.

Many of the jobs that today's students will be doing in 2030 haven't been invented yet. The big question is: What will these jobs be? It turns out that many of these jobs will spin off from technologies that are emerging today and incorporate skills that can be learned through education.

Career-services experts predict the following top jobs for 2030 (Table 1), while the World Economic Forum has listed the most essential skills for the jobs of the future (Table 2).

Table 1: Sample of most in-demand jobs for 2030 (Anderson, 2022)

- 1. organ creator \rightarrow 3D-print or genetically engineer human hearts, lungs, kidneys, etc.
- 2. Metaverse planner → Design experiences for business and leisure in virtual reality
- 3. earthquake forecaster → Predict when, where, and how severe earthquakes will be
- 4. algorithm bias auditor → Manage biases emerging from algorithms and machine learning
- 5. rewilder → Turn cities from concrete jungles into green spaces
- 6. human-machine manager → Optimize teamwork between humans, AI, and networked devices
- 7. drone traffic optimizer \rightarrow Maintain the safety of the skies as the use of drones increases
- 8. trash engineer → Ensure sustainability of cyclical disposal, recycling, or upcycling
